- enables tool for students to hear over 10,000 words pronounced by native English speakers

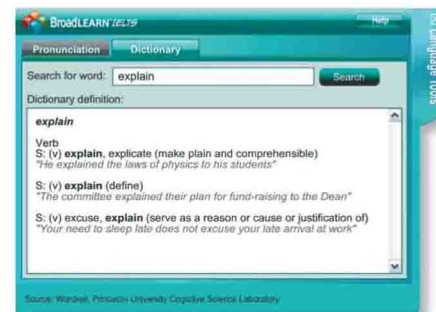
Audio recorder
